AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE RETIREMENT OF INCAPACITATED POLICE OFFICERS AND FIREFIGHTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 111F of chapter 41 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 149 of the acts of 1964, is hereby
3 further amended by inserting after the first sentence the following
4 sentence:—A police officer or firefighter who is incapacitated for a
5 period exceeding two years shall be retired or pensioned in accord-
6 ance with the law.
