

HOUSE No. 5924

By Mr. Connelly of Agawam, petition of Walter T. Kerr (by vote of the town) for legislation to provide that the position of chief of police in the city known as the town of Agawam shall be subject to the civil service law and rules. Public Service. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE POSITION OF CHIEF OF POLICE IN THE CITY KNOWN AS THE TOWN OF AGAWAM SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW AND RULES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter three hundred and six of the acts of
2 nineteen hundred and seventy-seven is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 2. The position of chief of police in the city known as
2 the town of Agawam shall be subject to the provisions of chapter
3 thirty-one of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
