AN ACT TO ALLOW TOWNS TO SPEND ADDITIONAL FUNDS TO MEET ENERGY COSTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to
2 the contrary, towns shall be allowed to spend additional funds to
3 meet energy costs which may be taken out of available funds. Such
4 expenditures to be confirmed by their respective regular town
5 meeting bodies. In the event additional energy costs funds become
6 necessary such funds shall be allocated by the board of selectmen
7 or by the town manager where one exists.
