Amick and Local 1313, of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, by Paul Daniels, president, for legislation to change the name of the Metropolitan State Hospital; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 955) of Donald J. Manning and Carol C. Amick for legislation to designate the administration building at the Metropolitan State Hospital as the William F. McLaughlin Building, reports recommending that the accompanying bill (House, No. 6101) ought to pass.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE NAME OF METROPOLITAN STATE HOSPITAL AND TO THE NAME OF ITS ADMINISTRATION BUILDING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 14A of Chapter 19 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking the words "Metropolitan State Hospi-
3 tal" in the first sentence and adding in place thereof the follow-
4 ing: —
5 "....Metropolitan Rehabilitation Center"

1 SECTION 2. The Metropolitan State Hospital will hereinafter
2 be referred to as the Metropolitan Rehabilitation Center in all
3 matters concerning this facility under the control of the Depart-
4 ment of Mental Health.

1 SECTION 3. The administration building at Metropolitan
2 State Hospital shall be designated and known as the William F.
3 McLaughlin Building. Suitable markers bearing said designation
4 shall be attached thereto by the department of mental health.
