AN ACT INCREASING THE TOTAL VALUE OF AN ESTATE CONSISTING ENTIRELY OF PERSONAL PROPERTY THAT QUALIFIES FOR INFORMAL ADMINISTRATION OR EXECUTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 16 of chapter 195 of
2 the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the word
3 “three”, inserted by chapter 209 of the acts of 1979, and inserting in
4 place thereof the word: — five.

1 SECTION 2. The first paragraph of section 16A of said chapter
2 195, as appearing in section 2 of chapter 744 of the acts of 1979, is
3 hereby amended by striking out, in line 4, the word “three” and
4 inserting in place thereof the word: — five.
