AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CLERK OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF EAST BOSTON TO ADJUST HIS BOOKS ON ACCOUNT OF MONEY STOLEN FROM HIS OFFICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The clerk of the district court of East Boston is
2 hereby authorized to adjust his accounts by deducting from his
3 cashbook receipts of money due to the county of Suffolk the sum of
4 \$319.00, which was the sum stolen from said court and not reco-
5 vered in a burglary during the day of March 31st, 1979.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon acceptance of the
2 City Council and Mayor of Boston.
