AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BERKSHIRE COUNTY TO DETERMINE THE FEASIBILITY OF RENOVATING THE EXISTING JAIL AND HOUSE OF CORRECTION IN SAID COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 126 of the Acts of 1979, is hereby amended by inserting
2 after the first sentence, the following sentence: — Said county
3 commissioners may also conduct a feasibility study for the renova-
4 tion and rehabilitation of the existing jail and house of correction
5 in Pittsfield for its continued use as a correctional facility for said
6 county.
