AN ACT AUTHORIZING BRISTOL COUNTY TO REFUND CERTAIN TEMPORARY LOANS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section thirty-  
2 seven B of chapter thirty-five of the General Laws, temporary  
3 notes issued by Bristol County in anticipation of the issue of serial  
4 bonds or notes under the provisions of chapter three hundred and  
5 ninety-seven of the acts of nineteen hundred and seventy-nine, may  
6 be refunded by the issue of other temporary notes, provided that  
7 the period from the date of issue of the original temporary notes to  
8 the date of maturity of the refunding notes shall not be more than  
9 two years.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
