The committee on Natural Resources and Agriculture, to whom were referred the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 369) of David B. Smith, Francis D. Doris and others that the Department of Environmental Quality Engineering be directed to dredge the Saugus River in the town of Saugus; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 1892) of Howard C. Cahoon, Jr., and another that provision be made for the expenditure of a certain sum of money by the Commonwealth to dredge Madaket Harbor in Nantucket; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2251) of Robert B. Ambler that the Division of Waterways be directed to dredge a channel to the Wessagussett Yacht Club; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2885) of Roger R. Goyette that the Division of Environmental Quality Engineering be directed to dredge the channel to the East Boston Yacht Club; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3626) of M. Joseph Manning relative to directing the Division of Waterways to dredge a portion of the Neponset River; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3628) of Alfred E. Saggese, Jr., that the Division of Waterways be directed to dredge the Belle Isle Inlet in the town of Winthrop and the city of Revere; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3798) of Emmanuel G. Serra and Michael LoPresti, Jr., relative to authorizing and directing the Division of Environmental Quality Engineering to dredge the channel to the East Boston Yacht Club; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 4954) of Michael W. Morrissey that the Department of Public Works be directed to dredge the channel between the Wollaston and Squantum yacht clubs; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 5820) of F. John Monahan that the Department of Environmental Quality Engineering be directed to dredge the Bass River Basin in the city of Beverly, reports recommending that the accompanying bill (House, No. 6312) ought to pass.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIVISION OF WATERWAYS
WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ENGINEER-
ING TO CONDUCT CERTAIN DREDGING PROJECTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The division of waterways within the department of environ-
2 mental quality engineering is hereby authorized and directed to
3 dredge the following areas: The Saugus River in the Town of
4 Saugus; Madaket Harbor in the Town of Nantucket; the channel
5 to the Wessagussett Yacht Club, in the Town of Weymouth; the
6 channel to the East Boston Yacht Club in the City of Boston; the
7 Neponset River from the Granite Avenue Bridge inland for one-
8 quarter of a mile; the Belle Isle Inlet in the Town of Winthrop and
9 the City of Revere; the channel between the Wollaston and Squan-
10 tum Yacht Clubs and the Bass River in the City of Beverly. For the
11 implementation of the dredging projects in this act, the division of
12 waterways shall expend such sums as may be appropriated there-
13 for.
