AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO LAY OUT OR ALTER WAYS IN BEHALF OF A COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first and second sentences of section twenty-nine A of
2 chapter eighty-one of the General Laws are hereby amended so
3 that they read as follows:—

4 The department may lay out or alter ways other than state
5 highways in any county, city or town provided that federal aid may
6 be secured toward the damages sustained, and provided that the
7 county commissioners of the county, the mayor of the city or the
8 board of selectmen of the town consents thereto. Land or rights in
9 land may be acquired for this purpose by eminent domain under
10 chapter seventy-nine by the department in behalf of the county,
11 city or town in which the land lies
