## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty.

### AN ACT TO PREVENT DISCRIMINATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
- 2 out section 43, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, and
- 3 inserting in place thereof the following section:—
- 4 *Section 43.* The application of a citizen of the commonwealth
- 5 for employment in any department of the commonwealth or any
- 6 political subdivision thereof or in any department of a street rail-
- 7 way company, operated, owned, controlled or financially aided in
- 8 any way by the commonwealth, or by any political subdivision
- 9 thereof, shall not be affected by the applicant's national origin,
- 10 race, color, height or weight; provided, however, that an applica-
- 11 tion for employment as a police officer or firefighter may be
- 12 affected by a height and weight requirement
