AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ABILITY OF INSURANCE COMPANIES, BROKERS
AND AGENTS TO OFFSET PREMIUMS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 34 O of Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding the following sentence to the seventeenth
3 paragraph:

4 Said claim form shall indicate as to whether the insured is
5 current or not current in the payment of his automobile insurance
6 premiums.
