Salaries. For the salaries of the members, a sum not exceeding six hundred dollars.

Expenses. For travelling and other expenses, a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

*Chap.* 9 AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE BOARD OF REGISTRATION IN MEDICINE.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Appropriations, board of registration in medicine.

SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, for the salaries and expenses of the board of registration in medicine, for the fiscal year ending on the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and thirteen, to wit:—

Salaries. For the salaries of the members of the board, forty-three hundred dollars.

Expenses. For travelling and other expenses of the board, a sum not exceeding four hundred and fifty dollars.

Clerk. For the clerk of the board, the sum of eight hundred dollars.

Printing, postage, etc. For printing, postage, office supplies and contingent expenses of the members of the board, to include printing the annual report, a sum not exceeding eight hundred dollars.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

*Chap.* 10 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE MASSACHUSETTS INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

SECTION 1. The sum of one hundred thousand dollars is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, to the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
