AN ACT

In further addition to "An Act respecting Public Worship
and Religious Freedom."

1 **BE** *it enacted by the Senate and House of*
2 *Representatives in General Court assembled, and by*
3 *the authority of the same, That after the passing of*
4 *this act, no person who has been a voter in any ter-*
5 *ritorial parish, and has ceased to be a member there-*
6 *of by any act except a removal without its limits,*
7 *shall again become a voter therein in any way but by*
8 *the consent of such parish given by vote in a legal*

9 meeting thereof warned for that purpose ; or by vir-
 10 tue of a certificate of the clerk of such parish accord-
 11 ing to the provisions of the statute of eighteen hun-
 12 dred and twenty three, chapter one hundred and six ;
 13 which certificate it shall be within the discretion of
 14 such clerk to give or to withhold, according to the
 15 directions or instructions which may be given to him
 16 by such parish, or a committee thereof, elected for this
 17 purpose : And all laws inconsistent herewith are
 18 hereby repealed.
