RESOLVES

For a reimbursement of the expenses incurred in taking a Geographical Survey of the Commonwealth.

RESOLVED, That there be paid out of the Treasury of this Commonwealth, to the City of Boston and to the several Towns whose certificates have been transmitted to, and registered in the Secretary's Office, such sums as appear to have been actually expended in making surveys of their territories, pursuant to a Resolve of March 1, 1830. - *Provided, however,* That the town of Springfield, in the county of Hampden, shall receive \$122 50, and

no more. And His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of Council, is hereby authorized and requested to draw his warrant accordingly.

RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Commonwealth be directed to notify and require such towns as have not transmitted their certificates, to make returns thereof to the Secretary's office before

And all certificates returned agreeably to the requisitions of this Resolve, shall be audited by the Treasurer of the Commonwealth. And the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of Council, is authorized and empowered to draw his warrant accordingly.

AMENDMENT

And Provided further, That no such payment shall be made to any city or town, until the provisions of the eighth section of *An Act to provide for the Instruction of Youth*, passed March 10th, 1827, shall have been complied with by the proper officers of such city or town, for the year *one thousand eight hundred and thirty three.*
