AN ACT

In addition to An Act concerning County Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

1 SECT. 1. In all future elections of county commis-
2 sioners and special commissioners, the board of
3 examiners in the several counties whose duty it is
4 to examine the returns of votes, shall meet and dis-
5 charge the duties required by law as to such elections,
6 on the first Wednesday of the month next succeeding
7 the election of any such officers.

1 SEC. 2. So much of the fourteenth chapter of the
2 Revised Statutes as is inconsistent with this act, is
3 hereby repealed.
