RESOLVE

On the Petition of Martin Wheelock.

*Resolved*, For reasons set forth in the said Petition, that there be allowed and paid out of the Treasury of the Commonwealth to Martin Wheelock, of Gardner, in the county of Worcester, the sum of thirty dollars a year, for the term of three years, from the twelfth day of June, in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four, should he live so long, and that warrants be drawn accordingly.
