

HOUSE....No. 124.

Mr. HUNTINGTON offers the following amendments to the Bill concerning the Manufacture and Sale of Spirituous and Intoxicating Liquors.

In printed copy of the Bill :—

Sect. 2, 24th line, after the word “druggist,” insert the following words, “or the clerk or agent of such druggist.”

Sect. 10, 2d line, after the word “the,” insert these words, “provisions of the.”

Sect. 13, 2d line, after the words “city marshal” insert the words, “deputy or assistant marshal.”

Sect. 14. At the close of the section add the following, “or they may put such bond in suit without said complaint, notice, or hearing.”

Sect. 20, 2d line, after the word “State,” insert the words,— “or who shall convey from place to place within the same.”

Sect. 23. 39th line, after the word “arrested,” insert, “shall be discharged, and.”

Sect. 25, 30th line, after the word “deposited,” strike out the words, “but no warrant shall issue for the search of any dwelling-house,” and insert as follows:—

1 “And if the place to be searched be a dwelling
2 house, used and occupied exclusively as such, and no
3 tavern, store, grocery, eating room, or place of com-
4 mon resort be kept therein, such warrant shall not be
5 issued,” &c.

Sect. 27, line 17, after the word "by," strike out the words, "any person," and insert these words, "the person alleged in the complaint."

Same Sect., in lines 32 and 33, strike out the words, "pure and unadulterated and."

Same Sect., 40th and 41st lines, strike out the words, "not pure and unadulterated," and insert the following, "not suitable for use as aforesaid."

Sect. 30, 16th line, after the word "before," insert the word "which."

Sect. 31, line 14, after the word "seized," strike out the remainder of the section, and substitute the following :—

1 "And to make complaint for the arrest and trial of
2 such person or persons, and for the seizure and con-
3 fiscation of such liquors, according to the provisions
4 of this Act."

Sect. 34, line 6, strike out the word "public," and insert "common."

Sect. 36. Add at the end of the section these words :—

1 "But nothing herein contained shall prevent the
2 commencement of such suit after the expiration of
3 said sixty days."

Sect. 37, 3d and 4th lines, after the word "same," strike out these words, "and the apartments or rooms where the same may be kept, used, or sold."

Same Sect., line 17. Strike out all after the word "Commonwealth," down to the word "for," in the 21st line.

Sect. 38, 4th line. Strike out the word "competent," and after the word "court," in the fifth line, insert the words, "competent to try the same."

Same Sect., 6th line. Strike out the word "person," and substitute the word "officer."

Same Sect. At the end of the section add as follows :—

1 “And if any sheriff, deputy sheriff, marshal, con-
2 stable, or other officer, to whom any warrant, search
3 warrant, process, or precept, provided for in this Act,
4 may be directed, shall neglect or refuse to serve and
5 execute the same, he shall be liable to a fine not ex-
6 ceeding dollars, and it shall be a sufficient
7 cause for removal or dismissal from office; and for
8 any loss or damage arising to him, without fault or
9 negligence on his part, in consequence of obedience
10 to any precept, process, or warrant aforesaid, duly
11 served, indemnity, if claimed, shall be claimed of the
12 Commonwealth, after the loss or damage sustained,
13 and in no other manner.”

Sect. 39, 8th line, after the word “commenced,” insert the words, “or any rights acquired or liabilities incurred.”

Same Sect., 10th line. Strike out the last sentence all after the word “effect.”
