AN ACT

Concerning the Taxation of Minors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. All personal property belonging to
2 minors under guardianship shall be assessed to the
3 guardian in the town where the minor may reside and
4 have his home.
