AN ACT

Establishing the Pay of Assessors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The forty-fifth section of the seventh
2 chapter of the Revised Statutes is hereby so far
3 amended as to make the sum to be paid to each assess-
4 or by his town, for every whole day that he shall be
5 employed in that service, one dollar and fifty cents,
6 together with such other compensation as the town
7 shall allow.

1 SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect from and after
2 its passage.
