AN ACT

In amendment of an Act entitled "An Act to authorize Towns to take Land for School-Houses."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The two hundred and thirty-seventh
2 chapter of the statutes of the year one thousand
3 eight hundred and forty-eight is hereby amended
4 by striking out the word "forty," and inserting there-
5 for the word *eighty*, in the first section of said statute.

1 SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
2 with the first section of this act are hereby repealed.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect on and after
2 its passage.
