SIR: — The Board of Registration in Embalming respectfully submits the following as its annual report for the year ending Nov. 30, 1920.

The Board organized as follows: Peter H. Savage, chairman; Frederick L. Briggs, secretary; Willard P. Staples, member.

During the year there have been 7 meetings, also 2 regular examinations to qualify applicants to practice embalming within the State.

There appeared at the March examination 65 applicants, of whom 33 qualified and were registered; at the October examination there appeared 59 applicants, of whom 39 qualified, making a total of 72 for the year.

There are 1,264 registered embalmers who paid the annual fee entitling them to practice embalming; 61 failed to pay renewal fee, thereby automatically invalidating their registration.
