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OF FINANCE

To Mrs. Hazel G. Oliver, Director of Registration:

Dear Madam: The Board of Registration in Embalming and Funeral Directing has the honor to submit to you its annual report for the year ending November 30, 1942.

Two examinations for registration as Embalmer were conducted during the year, one on March 4, 1942 and the other October 7, 1942. A total of 77 candidates were examined, of which 52 were issued certificates of registration.

The Board also conducted two examinations for registration as Funeral Director, on December 3, 1941 and June 3, 1942 respectively. A total of 87 candidates were examined of which 51 were successful and 36 rejected.

During the year the Board suspended 1 certificate of registration as Embalmer and 2 registrations as Funeral Director.

On May 26-27, a meeting for Disseminating Knowledge to Embalmers and Funeral Directors was held at the Copley Square Hotel, Boston, Mass. Another such meeting was held at the Hotel Bancroft, Worcester, Mass., September 16, 1942.

At the annual meeting of the Board held October 6, 1942, Ernest H. Sparrell was re-elected Chairman and Frederick A. Cookson, elected Secretary for the ensuing year.

Frank M. Forastiere, Springfield, Mass., was re-appointed by His Excellency Leverett Saltonstall, on October 7, 1942 for a term of three years.
