AN ACT

To repeal a part of an Act in addition to an Act to incorporate certain persons for the purpose of building a Bridge over Merrimack River, in the County of Middlesex, between the Towns of Dracut and Chelmsford.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. So much of “An Act in addition to an
2 Act to incorporate certain persons for the purpose of
3 building a bridge over Merrimack River, in the
4 county of Middlesex, between the towns of Dracut
5 and Chelmsford,” passed in the year of our Lord, one
6 thousand eight hundred and forty-three, as recites,
7 alleges or declares, that the sum of ten thousand dol-

8 lars of the original cost of the bridge therein named
9 had not then been reimbursed and repaid to the pro-
10 prietors thereof, is hereby repealed.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after
2 its passage.
