RESOLVE

Concerning Idiotic Children.

Resolved, That the sum annually paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth to the treasurer of the Massachusetts School for Idiotic and Feeble-Minded Youth, according to a Resolve approved by the governor April thirtieth, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and fifty-one, be increased to seven thousand five hundred dollars: *provided*, that said sum be used and applied according to the conditions of said Resolve.
