**AN ACT CLARIFYING THE INVESTIGATIVE POWERS OF THE DISABLED PERSONS  
PROTECTION COMMISSION.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Subsection (c) of Section 3 of Chapter 19C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding "physical, mental, or financial" after "alleged."
