AN ACT RELATIVE TO ADVERTISEMENTS FOR THE SALE OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 255B of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-
- 2 Section 26. In an advertisement for the sale of a motor vehicle under this chapter, the retail sales shall cause the
- 3 printed ad to display the amount of money required in cash or trade in print size equal to or larger than the asking
- 4 price.
