The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Nine

AN ACT EXEMPTING THE TOWN OF NORTH ANDOVER FROM PROVISIONS OF THE
PREVAILING WAGE LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the town of
- 2 North Andover shall be exempt from sections 26 through 27G of chapter 149 of the General Laws for
- 3 projects estimated to cost \$50,000 or less.
- 4 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
