AN ACT REQUIRING VOTERS TO FURNISH IDENTIFICATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 50 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the
2 following section:—

3 Section 9. All persons voting at a primary or election shall produce valid proof of their identity
4 before so voting.
