AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PROTECTION OF PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 150A of chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence the following definition:-

3 "Contaminated soil", soil that contains oil or hazardous materials as a result of a release to the
4 environment.

5 SECTION 2. Section 150A of chapter 111 is hereby amended by inserting at the end of the
6 section, the following paragraph:-

7 Contaminated soil is prohibited from being disposed of, stored, stockpiled, used as landfill cover,
8 or used as fill material for any and all purposes within the boundaries of the zone of contribution
9 of any public or private groundwater drinking water supply or of the watershed of any surface
10 drinking water supply.
