AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 3 of chapter 176D is hereby amended by adding to subsection 9 the following:
- 2 (o) Requiring an injured person to submit to physical examination by practitioners registered or
- 3 licensed under the provisions of one hundred and twelve, and who are selected by the insurer, with
- 4 unreasonable frequency (presumed to be more frequently than once each six months except in unusual
- 5 circumstances), or at an unreasonable time or at an unreasonable distance from the injured person's
- 6 residence.
