AN ACT RELATIVE TO RED LIGHT CAMERAS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 113B of Chapter 175, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby
2 amended by striking out the clause " convictions of moving violations of motor vehicle laws," in Line
3 191 and inserting in place thereof the following new clause:-
4 " convictions of moving violations of motor vehicle laws , except violations of traffic control
5 devices that involve the implementation of red light cameras, so-called,"
