AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MEDICAID PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. The definition of "ambulatory surgical center" in section 1 of Chapter 118G of the
- 2 General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the
- 3 following sentence:- A single-specialty ambulatory surgical center which is licensed by the
- 4 commonwealth shall be included herein and shall be qualified for full participation in the
- 5 Medicaid program.
