AN ACT RESTRICTING THE MASSACHUSETTS HIGHER EDUCATION CONSORTIUM
FROM CHARGING A FEE FOR PROVIDING QUALIFIED BIDDERS WITH ELECTRONIC BID

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 24A of Chapter 15A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2 amended by adding after the sentence ending with "certified public accountant";
- 3 There shall be no fee associated with providing electronic bid information to pre-qualified bidders.
