## AN ACT RELATIVE TO DEFINING EMPLOYEES IN GROUP 2.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 32 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2002 Official Edition, is hereby  
2 amended by inserting in section 3 (g), in line 242, after the word "hospital," the following new  
3 words:-  
4 "employees of the trial court of the Commonwealth who hold the position of court service  
5 coordinator, assistant court service coordinator, chief housing specialist, housing specialist,  
6 psychologist, court reporter, court interpreter, professional, clerical and other employees whose  
7 duty and responsibilities bring them in contact with criminal defendants and others whose court  
8 appearance is required."
