## AN ACT RELATIVE TO BLUNT WRAPS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 64 e, section 1 is amended at the end of the first paragraph by adding, "blunt wraps, which shall
- 2 mean a cigar wrap made from tobacco".
- 3 Chapter 270, section 6 is amended in line 1 after the word "tobacco" by adding the words, "blunt wraps".
- 4 Chapter 270, section 6 is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:
- 5 "It is unlawful for a person engaged in the retail sale of blunt wraps to place or maintain, or to cause to be
- 6 placed or maintained, any blunt wraps advertising display within two feet of candy, snack, or
- 7 nonalcoholic beverage displayed inside any store or business. Further, it is unlawful for any person or
- 8 business to place or maintain, or caused to be placed or maintained, any blunt wrap advertising display
- 9 that is less than four feet above the floor."
