In the Year Two Thousand and Nine

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A WOMEN'S CORRECTIONAL FACILITY IN MIDDLESEX COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 There shall be established in Middlesex County, a Women's Correctional Facility. Said facility
- 2 shall be operated, administered and staffed by the Middlesex Sheriff. The facility shall house
- 3 women convicted of a crime that provides for a house of correction sentence and women
- 4 detained while awaiting trial.
