AN ACT TO CREATE PENALTIES FOR MANSLAUGHTER WHEN CAUSED BY THE
OPERATION OF A MOTOR VEHICLE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 265 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is
2 hereby amended by adding the following section:—
3 Section 13½. Whoever commits manslaughter while operating a motor vehicle shall be punished
4 in the state prison for not more than twenty years or by a fine of not more than one thousand
5 dollars and imprisonment in jail or a house correction for not more than two and one-half years.
6 Upon a conviction under this section, the court shall immediately notify the registrar, who shall
7 suspend the license, permit or right to operate of such person for fifteen years.
