AN ACT GRANTING AUTHORITY OVER NOTARIES PUBLIC TO THE SECRETARY OF
STATE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 222 of the General Laws, or any other
2 general or special law, rule, regulation or executive order to the contrary, the secretary of state shall
3 promulgate rules and regulations for the conduct of notaries public and the performance of their official
4 duties and the enforcement thereof.

5 SECTION 2. Chapter 222 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 9, the
6 following section:—

7 Section 9A. A non-attorney notary public who advertises notarial services in a language other
8 than English shall include in the advertisement, notice, letterhead or sign the following prominently
9 displayed in the same language, the statement — I am not an attorney and have no authority to give
10 advice on immigration or other legal matters.
