*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 27A of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the second sentence of subsection (d).
