*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 32J of chapter 94C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is
2 hereby amended by striking out, in line 4 and 5, the words "accredited preschool, accredited headstart
3 facility" and inserting in place thereof the following words: "licensed preschool, licensed headstart
4 facility".
