In the Year Two Thousand and Nine

AN ACT INCREASING THE PENALTY FOR ASSAULT AND BATTERY ON A POLICE OFFICER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 13D of chapter 265 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in lines 4, 5 and 6 the words "for not less than ninety days nor
3 more than two and one-half years in a house of correction or by a fine of not less than five hundred nor
4 more than five thousand dollars" and inserting in their place the following words:- in the state prison for
5 not more than 5 years or by a fine of not more than \$5000, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
