The undersigned legislators and/or citizens respectfully petition for the passage of the accompanying bill:

An Act relative to Controlled Substances.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (a) of Class B of Section 31 of Chapter 94C of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, shall be amended by inserting the following item:-

3 (9) Kratom (*Mitragyna speciosa*), or any salt, compound, derivative, or preparation of kratom,
4 and any salt, compound, derivative, or preparation thereof which is chemically equivalent or identical
5 with kratom.

6 SECTION 2. Subsection (e) of Class C of Section 31 of Chapter 94C of the General Laws, as
7 appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, shall be amended by inserting the following items:-

8 (16) *Salvia Divinorum*;

9 (17) *Salvinorin A*;

10 (18) *Catha Edulis*.

11 SECTION 3. Subsection (12) of the definition of "Drug paraphernalia" under Section 1 of
12 Chapter 94C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, shall be amended by adding
13 the following items:-

14 (p) blunt wrappers;

15 (q) rose bud smoking pipes.
