AN ACT RELATIVE TO WORKERS' COMPENSATION DEPENDENCY BENEFITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 35A of chapter 152 of the General Laws is hereby amended by: 1. deleting the phrase
2 "six dollars" in the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the phrase "fifteen dollars" 2. deleting the
3 phrase "one hundred fifty dollars" in the second sentence and inserting in place thereof the phrase "three
4 hundred dollars" 3. deleting the phrase "six dollars" in the last sentence and inserting in place thereof the
5 phrase "fifteen dollars".
