Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Subsection 3 of section 1 of chapter 151B, as appearing in the 2006 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following:-
- 3 Except where such organization falls under the jurisdiction of the National Labor Relations Board.
