AN ACT RELATIVE TO CHILD LABOR LAWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 87 of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby
2 amended by inserting, in line 28, after the words "by said physician" the words:— "within twenty-four months prior
3 to the date on said certificate".
