AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF NORFOLK TO BORROW MONEY FOR THE PREPARATION OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR RENOVATION OF AND ADDITIONS TO THE PRESIDENTS GOLF COURSE CLUBHOUSE AT NORFOLK COUNTY'S WOLLASTON RECREATIONAL FACILITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of providing adequate and complete facilities at the county  
2 recreational facility, the county commissioners of Norfolk County are hereby authorized to  
3 renovate and make additions to the existing golf course clubhouse on land now owned by said  
4 county in the city of Quincy. Said commissioners are hereby further authorized to cause plans  
5 and specifications to be prepared for the renovation of and additions to said facilities; provided  
6 that such plans and specifications shall be so drawn that the total cost for such renovation and  
7 additions, including architect's fees and expenses connected therewith, shall not exceed five  
8 million dollars.

9 SECTION 2. For the purpose authorized by section one, the treasurer of said county, with the  
10 approval of the county commissioners, may borrow upon the credit of the county such sums as  
11 may be necessary, not exceeding in the aggregate, five million dollars; and may issue bonds or

12 notes of the county thereof, which shall bear upon their face the words, Norfolk County  
13 Wollaston Recreational Facility Loan Act of 2005. Each authorized issue shall constitute a  
14 separate loan, and such loans shall be payable in not more than twenty years from their dates.  
15 The bonds or notes shall be signed by the county treasurer and counter signed by a majority of  
16 the county commissioners. The county may sell said securities at public or private sale, upon  
17 such terms and conditions as the county commissioners may deem proper, but not for less than  
18 their par value. Indebtedness incurred hereunder shall, except as herein provided, be subject to  
19 chapter thirty-five of the General Laws.

20 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
