### AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE MASSACHUSETTS LAW ENFORCEMENT MEMORIAL FUND.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 10 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 35BB the  
2 following section:—

3 Section 35CC. There shall be established and set up on the books of the commonwealth a  
4 separate fund to be know as the Massachusetts Laws Enforcement Memorial Fund to be used  
5 without appropriation by a department of public safety for the purpose of making annual  
6 payments to the Massachusetts Law Enforcement Memorial to memorialize and honor  
7 Massachusetts law enforcement personnel killed in the line of duty. There shall be credited to  
8 the fund revenues received by the commonwealth from the sale of registration plates under  
9 section 2G of chapter 90.
