AN ACT RELATIVE TO RETIRED CAPITOL POLICE OFFICERS DISABLED IN THE
PERFORMANCE OF DUTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 90A of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as amended by section 2 of chapter 177 of the Acts of
2 1997, is hereby further amended by inserting after the word "officer", in line 15, the following words:— or, capitol
3 police officer.
