AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT RIGHTS OF MASSPORT EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1.

2           Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby amended to include  
3 mechanical maintenance men, consisting of plumbers, steam pipe fitters, facility technicians, building  
4 equipment mechanics, building mechanical maintenance man A, mechanical department foremen and  
5 immediate supervisors located at MASSPORT located at the Logan International Airport located in the  
6 City of Boston in Group 2 of the retirement system.
